

Country Store 2010

We are asking that each guild member contribute two quality items for the country store OR make a \$10 donation payable to the Guild. Members who have made the required contribution may sell consignment items in the Guild's Country Store. The Guild will receive a 20% commission on all sold consignment items. Consignment items must be marked for sale at \$2.00 +. Items marked less than \$2.00 will be considered a donation to the Guild. If you have smaller items, we suggest that you bundle or bag them to reach the \$2.00 threshold.

Suggested items for members to make

1. "Baked Potato" Sack
2. Chenille Pot Holder
3. EZ Rectangular Placemat
4. Oval Placemat with napkins
5. Covered Hangers
6. Knitted Cotton Dishcloths (8")

Other suggested items for sale:

These items have sold well in the past years:

- New or gently used quilts
- Quilt tops
- Quilt blocks to make an instant quilt (9 or 12 blocks per package)
- New quilted placemats with matching napkins in sets of 4 (see instructions attached)
- New quilted potholders (that sell for \$5 max) (see instructions attached)
- New quilted table runners
- New quilted wall hangings
- Pressed and nicely packaged quality quilt fabric (100% cotton only!)
- New knitted blankets, mittens, hats, washcloths (see instructions attached), scarves
- Used quilt tools and quilt notions, quilt hoops
- Used quilt or craft books
- Quilt magazines, bundled by type, year, or sets of 6
- Quilt frames (note: we do not have space to display these, so ask that you take a photo and we will have a bulletin board set up to promote these items)

These items DO NOT sell well and will not be accepted:

- Poor quality cotton polyester fabrics
- Dress/decorator fabrics
- Clothes patterns
- Christmas ornaments which are NOT handmade
- Garage Sale items

We are accepting donations and consignment items at the General Meetings, at the Farmhouse, and at board meetings.

We ask that you price your consignment items and donation items, but the Country Store Committee reserves the right to re-price the donated items. Use plain tags for the donation items.

Unsold items should be picked up AT END OF THE SHOW. Any remaining items may be donated to charity.
